- 5. Must be a US Citizen or hold a permanent resident visa card.
- 6. Must submit all application materials listed below by 6:00p.m. ET on Tuesday, April 30, 2024:
 - i. Application Questionnaire;
 - ii. Copy of transcript showing cumulative GPA;
 - iii. IMPORTANT NOTES TO THE APPLICANT ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

- The VOOS Scholarship Selection Committee will convene as early as April 1, 2024, to
 determine the number of "Hatchett Scholars" to be selected from each of the participating
 Boys & Girls Clubs and will begin consideration of applications it has received from each
 participating Club as of April 1, 2024. The Selection Committee will convene thereafter to
 consider additional applications it has received from each participating Club through the
 application deadline of Tuesday, April 30, 2024.
- Funding is available to designate ten (10) new Hatchett Scholars from the overall pool of applicants in 2024. Those who are selected as Hatchett Scholars will become eligible to utilize their \$2,000.00 scholarship for college admissions tests and higher education.
 - VOOS Scholarship funds will be held in a Boys & Girls Club of Broward County ("BGCBC") account and may be used by Hatchett Scholars to cover the cost of PSAT, SAT, ACT, and SAT tests and the preparation materials/courses and tutoring for any of these tests. Unused funds may be applied to college tuition.
- To remain eligible for VOOS funding, Hatchett Scholars must:
 - Complete a PSAT test preparation course sponsored by Kaplan, Princeton Review, Varsity Tutors, PrepScholar or a similarly rigorous program and take the PSAT during the fall of 10th grade.
 - Complete a SAT/ACT test preparation course sponsored by Kaplan, Princeton Review, Varsity Tutors, PrepScholar or similarly rigorous program and take the SAT/ACT during their 11th grade.
 - NOTE: If a Hatchett Scholar has verified that they have already enrolled in and completed rigorous and effective test preparation paid by another source and completed the required tests, then all or any remaining portion of their VOOS Scholarship funding may accrue in a BGCBC account as a college scholarship and shall be distributed on behalf of that Hatchett Scholar pursuant to BGCBC guidelines for awarding college scholarships.
- At any time, the VOOS Scholarship Committee, through a designated Boys & Girls Club liaison, may request updated transcripts of any Hatchett Scholar. Updated transcripts and final grades must be submitted at the end of the 2023/2024 school year and the 2024/2025 school year in order for the VOOS Scholarship funds to be disbursed.
- Neither The Boys & Girls Clubs nor the JWH Vaults of Opportunity Scholarship Program will support the complete financial needs of any applicant selected as a Hatchett Scholar.
